



## Care of your Solana RX Spa – Silver Ion / MPS System

Water Capacity: 245 Gallons

### **At Start-up**

Fill spa: Adjust pH using test strips and pH Decreaser. Add pH decriaser slowly, not more than ½ TBSP at a time. Run the jets for 15 minutes, then retest.. Add pH decriaser slowly, not more than ½ TBSP at a time. Run the jets for 15 minutes, then retest... Add 2 teaspoons of the Dichlor (Chlorine - Bottle with Blue cap)

Add 1 Ounce of Stain and scale defense.

### **At each use:**

Add 1-1/2 TBSP of MPS (non-chlorine shock). It's best if you add this before you use the spa, but after is OK too.

### **Weekly:**

Add 2 teaspoons of the Dichlor (Chlorine) 12 hours before use and run the jets for 10-30 minutes. Cycle the smart jet valve so that the chlorine spreads to all parts of the spa's internal plumbing.

Add 1 ounce of stain and scale defense. This prevents build-up of scale on the equipment.

### **Monthly:**

Disconnect power and remove filter. Spray with instant filter cleaner, let sit for 15 minutes, and hose off. Reinstall filter and reapply power.

### **Every Four months:**

Perform weekly chlorine shock, then drain the spa. Clean inside the shell with a rag, and if needed, a very little bit of well-diluted detergent, (most likely you will only need to do this at the water line.)

Replace the FreshWater silver Ion Cartridge.

Refill the spa using the above instructions for Start-up.

### **High Use:**

After many people have been in the spa, it is a good idea to add the Dichlor per the above weekly care instructions, even if your week is not yet up. If you ever have cloudy water, make sure the pH is good and add Chlorine per the weekly instructions. Continue adding the Chlorine daily until the water clears (usually in 3 days).

NOTE: Check the pH Level weekly. The pH Will likely increase over time, requiring the addition of pH Decreaser. Hi pH will result in cloudy water and may cause skin irritation.
